**Chamblee, GA, February 18, 2015** – by Trey Benton – Called Georgia's "Not Buying It" Pledge, the City of Chamblee committed Tuesday evening to work to stop child sex trafficking by participating in the "Not Buying It" program developed by the Governor's Office for Children and Families Statewide Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children Task Force.

As part of the pledge, Chamblee City Officials commit to:

- Walk with integrity by not supporting businesses or activities that perpetuate child sex trafficking;
- To exhibit courage by raising awareness, speaking out against commercial sexual exploitation of children, and reversing today's distorted perception of sex;
- and, to leave a legacy by mentoring the next generation to walk with integrity and exhibit the courage to eradicate the commercial exploitation of children from the face of the earth.

Earlier this year, Georgia's Attorney General Sam Olens joined forces with law enforcement and non-profit advocates to take a stand against criminals who purchase sex from children.
