

## Fourth Lyons man arrested in sex trafficking case

A fourth Wayne County man is facing charges stemming from a sex trafficking investigation.

Robbin L. Knight-Collins, 27, of Lyons, was arrested on Monday night following a traffic stop.

Knight-Collins is charged with criminal sale of a controlled substance to a child, third-degree rape, third-degree sex abuse, and endangering the welfare of a child, according to the Wayne County Sheriff's Office.

He was wanted after a grand jury indicted Jarvis J. Streeter, 32, of Lyons, in connection with a sex trafficking investigation. Streeter allegedly sexually abused a 15-year-old girl over a four-year period and got her addicted to crack cocaine. Streeter is accused of arranging for the girl to have sex with older men in exchange for drugs. Two other Lyons men were arrested and charged in connection with the case last week.

Knight-Collins made arrangements to turn himself in on Dec. 22. He failed to follow through on that agreement. According to a release from the Wayne County Sheriff's Office, investigators were given information that Knight-Collins was "hiding out" from police. They received information that he was seen operating a vehicle that belonged to a female associate.

Knight-Collins was arraigned in Town of Lyons Court and remanded to the county jail in lieu of mail.

The investigation is ongoing and more people are expected to face charges.
