Rochester man sentenced for sex trafficking

A Rochester man convicted of conspiracy to commit sex trafficking of a minor was sentenced to time served.

Otis Willis Jr., 33, was sentenced Wednesday to time served (two years) by Chief U.S. District Judge Frank P. Geraci Jr.

According to Assistant U.S. Attorneys Tiffany H. Lee and Bradley Lee, Willis worked with Tiffany St. Denis, who was convicted and sentenced to 31 months in prison, to entice a female victim younger than 18 to engage in sexual acts for commercial profit.

St. Denis posted advertisements online for a female victim to engage in prostitution and Willis then paid for hotel rooms at the Red Roof Inn between January and August 2012.
