

# 3 arrested in Wayne County sex trafficking case

Three Wayne County men were arrested in connection with a sex trafficking case this week.

All of the charges in this investigation stem from the initial arrest of Jarvis Streeter, 32, of Lyons. According to the Wayne County Sheriff's

Office, Streeter is accused of raping an 11-year-old girl. The child was 11 years old when the sex began with Streeter in November 2010. It continued until June 2015.

Streeter was originally facing charges of first-degree rape, first-degree sexual abuse, first-degree course of sexual conduct against a child, and en-

dangering the welfare of a child. He has since been indicted by a Wayne County grand jury on additional charges, including predatory sex assault

against a child, third-degree rape, four counts of sex trafficking, and four counts of compelling prostitution.

He remains in the Wayne County Jail in lieu of \$50,000 cash bail or \$100,000 bond.

According to authorities, Streeter got the 15-year-old victim addicted to crack cocaine over the

summer. Streeter arranged for her to have sex with other men in exchange for drugs.

Shane Bohrer, 24, of Lyons, was charged on Tuesday with third-degree criminal sex act, criminal sale of a controlled substance, and endangering the welfare of a child. He was arraigned and remanded to the

Wayne County Jail. He is scheduled to reappear in court at a later date.

Clifton "Peter" Hunt, 48, of Lyons, was arrested on Wednesday. He was charged with third-degree rape, forcible touching, and endangering the welfare of a child. Hunt was arraigned and sent to the Wayne County Jail. He is scheduled to reappear in court at a later date.

More arrests and charges are pending.
